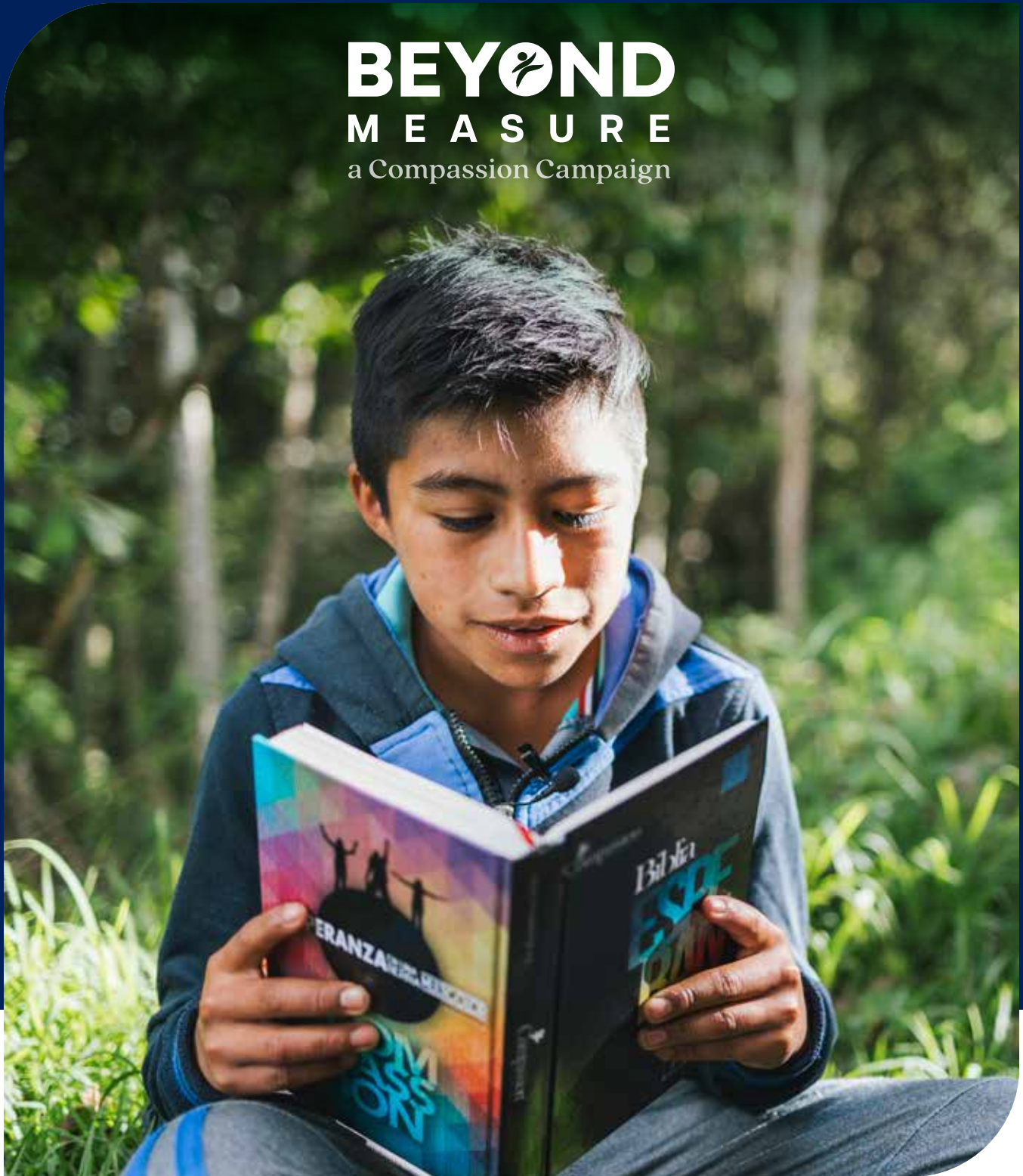

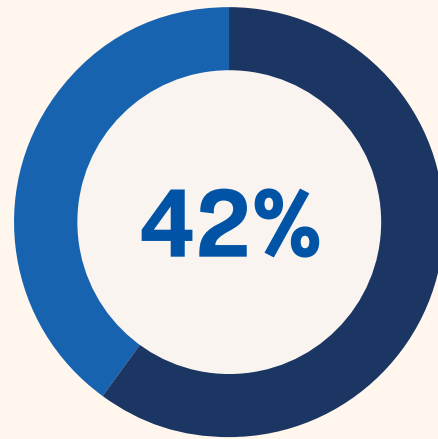

While too many young people today are growing up shrouded in the darkness of poverty, your generosity is empowering and mobilizing the body of Christ to transform thousands of these communities with hope.

Because of people like you saying “yes!” to the needs of these children, we are thrilled to share that we are 42% of the way toward reaching our campaign goal of \$1.3 billion! Every dollar raised is resulting in more vulnerable families experiencing a path out of poverty, better-equipped churches to care for the children in their neighborhoods, and greater capacity for Compassion to respond to new and emerging needs of children around the world. # Going to the Greatest Need

Compassion believes that the Church is God’s greatest instrument for releasing children from poverty – that is why all of our efforts are driven by and in partnership with local churches in communities of need. A committed and caring neighborhood church is a powerful force for good, as it intimately knows the people and needs of its community and is positioned to make a lasting difference.

It is a central goal of the Beyond Measure campaign to reach more children with greater speed and impact. To do this, it is critical that we equip more churches with the resources and training they need to open holistic child development centers. And through your generosity, that goal is becoming a reality.

**Since the start of the campaign, 775 new church-based child development centers have launched in neighborhoods of profound poverty!**

Remarkably, 35 of these centers were opened as a part of a brand new church plant in a community in need of a vibrant local congregation, an initiative made possible by the support of existing Frontline Church Partners (FCPs) and donors like you. And this is just the beginning! There are 23 more church plants in the process of being launched, with many more child development centers being planned at existing congregations as well.

## Spotlight on Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WaSH) Eliminating Barriers to Thriving

Access to safe water as well as good sanitation and hygiene practices are essential for child survival, development and growth. WaSH interventions reduce diseases and enable greater engagement in school, opening doors to far greater outcomes throughout the life of a child. This is why we take this issue seriously and equip our Frontline Church Partners to make these critical investments into each child's well-being.

Through your support of Expand Hope, you are empowering Compassion's Frontline Church Partners to identify the best possible WaSH solutions for their communities and work proactively to eliminate related obstacles to the health and well-being of young people. Some of the solutions you've helped make possible this past year include:

- Construction of 2,601 sanitation facilities such as latrines and toilets
- Drilling of 139 boreholes and wells
- Development of 385 water treatment solutions at churches and individual households
- Provision of storage tanks for safe water in 295 communities
- Education on healthy hygiene practices in 360 communities

By eliminating these preventable risks to a child's life and well-being, you are helping them thrive and sharing a transformational resource for the entire community. Thank you for putting these life-saving solutions in the hands of those who need them most!

## Spotlight on Non-Formal Education Creative Approaches to Learning

Meaningful education for kids takes place beyond just the classroom. They also need enrichment opportunities that develop their unique skills, interests and capabilities – both for their personal well-being and their future economic self-sufficiency. For children growing up in poverty, however, even the most basic opportunities to look beyond their immediate needs are often out of reach.

But through your support of Beyond Measure, you are empowering churches to find creative ways to develop the God-given potential of every child in our care. These locally-driven solutions are designed with each unique child in mind, including resources such as the following this past year:

- 1,081 vocational/technical workshops and related costs
- 33 instances of tools and equipment provided to groups for income-generating activities
- 543 camps and cohorts of internships and apprenticeships
- 8 entrepreneurship trainings
- 453 interventions related to computer labs, seminars, libraries and playgrounds

Recent studies showed that, compared to their peers, Compassion-assisted youth between the ages of 15-18 were:

more likely to participate in post-secondary education and training  
(Ethiopia, 2021)

**47%**  
more likely to have at least one income-generating skill  
(Indonesia, 2021)

**63%**  
more likely to receive training in computer literacy  
(Ecuador, 2021)





## New Capabilities in Child Development Data-Informed, Church-Driven

The development and implementation of the Life Transformation Platform is one of the most consequential initiatives happening at Compassion today. Any steps we can take to improve life outcomes for the children we serve are worth our time and investment, but the opportunities you are making possible through this initiative represent huge leaps in the impact of our global ministry to children.

As we empower our Frontline Church Partners with greater tools, data, training and ownership of the child development program, we are seeing new ideas and greater collaboration come to life each and every day. **And the ripple effects of your generous support of this effort will be felt around the world for generations to come.**

In Tanzania, the first country to pilot the Life Transformation Platform, years of investment are showing powerful dividends. Today, all 545 church partners are actively using these new capabilities to continuously improve their ministries to children, and stories of impact continue to surface.

In one area, a cluster of 13 churches began to identify a need for greater safeguards around child protection in each of their villages. In response, they worked together to design and launch a public advocacy campaign around abuse prevention to educate their communities. In addition to greater safety for children, the campaign is also giving our church partners greater confidence in their ability to identify and meet the needs of local children.

On behalf of these churches and the children they serve, thank you for increasing the impact of this holistic child development program!

“Through the FCP planning process, we can see that churches are able to identify the needs of the children within their communities and explore ways their churches can address those needs. As a result of this process, churches are becoming more visible and are invited to participate in community development meetings, making their voices heard. Local authorities support FCPs in the participant selection process, while health centers assist by conducting monthly or quarterly health checks for participants. Furthermore, community members are actively collaborating with the church to provide care and support for the children.”

“During community information gathering a group of female youth was eager to share about their hygiene needs. One piece of information they shared was about school absenteeism during their menstrual periods. This need was prioritized, and a decision was made to have the Survival caregivers include the stitching of reusable sanitary towels as part of their tailoring program. The sanitary towels are now being given to girls and female caregivers in that FCP. This will go a long way in increasing school attendance and eventual completion rates among the female participants.”

## Responding to Unexpected Challenges

# Medical Care at a Moment's Notice

Nothing is more frightening for parents than to see their child's life in danger. While living in poverty brings countless threats to the health of children, they are also especially vulnerable to major health issues that may require sudden or complex treatment beyond the capabilities of local health services. And without resources to pay for medical care or sufficient clinics or hospitals nearby, a curable condition can quickly become fatal.

**In situations where a single minute could mean life or death, the flexible funding that you provide gives our church partners the capability to intervene in whatever means necessary to save the life of a child.**

In the last six months alone, 20 children have undergone life-saving heart surgeries that were made possible because of your support. Interventions like these often require transporting children to specialty hospitals in distant cities or countries, an impossible option for the families we serve without the generosity of people like you. We can't thank you enough for making it all possible!



## Responding to Emerging Opportunities

# Proactive Investments in Lifelong Health

While being prepared for medical crises is critical for our ministry, we know that it's even better if we can take the proactive steps to prevent disease before it ever impacts the life of a child. Since the health landscape varies in every community and country where we work, having the financial flexibility to work with our Frontline Church Partners to design preventive interventions that go beyond our normal child development program makes a profound difference for families. Preventive care is also more affordable than reactive care for our church partners, so these investments bring greater financial sustainability to our global ministry.

**Your partnership is playing a major role in enabling church-driven health initiatives in communities around the world, protecting children and securing their future health.**

Starting with birth, proactive care such as growth monitoring, nutritional supplements and vaccinations establish a strong foundation for a healthy childhood. In communities where vector-borne diseases are a constant threat, investments into tools like mosquito nets can protect families for many years. Providing access to healthy food prevents malnourishment that would otherwise have a lifelong impact. And community education on healthy habits and hygiene practices have ripple effects that touch all parts of a child's life.

You are making all of this possible, giving churches the confidence to take the lead in community health and preventive care for children in their neighborhoods. Thank you!
